

ECC Recommendation on GNSS jamming/spoofing operations (FM44 activities)



- **Development of An ECC Recommendation**
 - Development of coordination measures to limit the impact of approved RNSS jamming and spoofing operations on GNSS users from other sectors, in response to requests from Resolution 676 (WRC-23)
- **Draft Recommendation recommends**
 - to strengthen cooperation between stakeholders including authorised governmental users of jamming and spoofing equipment and civil aviation authorities, maritime authorities, affected ministries and national radio regulator as appropriate to reduce as far as practicable interference risks to GNSS receivers that may stem from the activities of these authorised governmental users
 - Guidelines to establish national procedures preparing and coordinating the use of GNSS jamming and spoofing
 - Criteria for to define affected area for GNSS jamming and spoofing operations
 - Examples of warning notice to minimize negative effects upon maritime and aeronautical operations
- **The draft Recommendation is proposed to be in public consultation in February 2026**
