Vietnam



In 2022:

- GDP: 401,7 tỷ USD; growth rate: 8,02%
- Per Capital Income: 4,110 USD
- 208.300 new established companies

Target GDP growth rate 2023: 6,5%

World Bank, S&P Global and Stardart Charterd show their belief in this target.

IMF forecast in 2025, Vietnam's economic scale will rank the third in Southeast Asia with GDP 571,1 Billion USD, after Indonesia (1.628,9 Billion USD) and Thailand (632,4 Billion USD) with growth ration of 6.5% in the next 10 years.

Vietnam still maintains a strong attraction to FDI inflows.

In 2022:

- Total registered capital is 27.2 billion USD
- Total implemented capital is up to 22.4 billion USD, the highest in the last 5 years.

In the first 7 months of 2023, 16.24 billion USD of registered FDI capital was recorded.





TRAINING ON ICT






- 158 universities and 442 vocational schools providing training courses/programs on ICT with 55,000 enrollment annually.

Digital institution

- **100**% ministries and provinces have established the Steering Committee on Digital transformation
- **55/63** provinces have Resolution on Digital transformation issued by the Local Communist Party Committee
- **19/22** ministries and **59/63** provinces have launched sectoral and local Programs/Plans on Digital transformation for 5-year period
- **16/22** ministries and **44/63** provinces have launched sectoral and local Action plan on Digital Transformation for 2022

INCENTIVES IN ICT DEVELOPMENT

Tax incentives

- Corporate income tax: 10% or first 4 years exemption and 50% reduction for the next 9 years applied to new ICT projects
- Import tax: exemption for importing devices or spart parts for R&D and manufacturing high-tech hardware, software, digital contents
- **Export tax:** 0% for exporting hardware and software
- VAT: exemption for software and IT services

Investment and export credits

- Software in regulated in a list of goods with export credits
- Manufacturing spare parts, software and IT services shall be provided incentives in National Science and Technology Fund

Land and water surface rent exemption incentives

- ICT Projects in special investment sectors in regions facing extreme socio-economic difficulties
- R & D facilities

IT Park incentives

• R&D projects in hardware, software, digital content in IT parks shall be provided incentives in Government's Decree no 154/2013/ND-CP similar to the regulation of high-tech park (land rent, Internet fee, etc)


