THE CHALLENGE

Lancashire Constabulary had to train **5,000** police officers and staff on CONNECT - their police case management system. They needed:

- Consistent training given the sensitivity of the information held - case records, investigations, intelligence and custody records.
- Compliant training adhering to national standards on security and data protection.
- To minimise abstractions from front-line policing and core duties.

THE SOLUTION

Using Me Learning's **LearnStream** methodology, we developed 203 bite-size modules configured into 11 role-tailored courses plus a core course to give all staff a baseline level of knowledge. The training was delivered through our own secure cloud-based learning platform underpinned by our Cyber Essentials Plus, ISO 27001 and ISO 9001 accreditations.

- **Reduced impact on front-line policing** and minimised time away from core duties through role-tailored training delivered in an instant digital environment.
